





Behind the elegant fronts of the wall units in brushed gold bronze aluminium, the award-winning MultiMatic makes clever use of storage space. The tall cabinets on the right, in dark walnut flamed veneer panels, house some of the appliances and conclude in the corner with a SieMatic SecretSpace tall cabinet, an absolute highlight in its combination of aesthetics and innovative functionality.

The island in the centre of the room, finished in a special velvet matte SQ lacquer, is both the command centre of the kitchen and the family dining area. Throughout the kitchen, the imaginative colour scheme is a testament to the courage of contrasts, while golden bronze acts as a unifying element in this exquisite palette.

SieMatic has consistently demonstrated its pioneering spirit with surprising developments, setting standards that have become the benchmark for the industry. The DNA of the SieMatic S2 includes ergonomically perfect horizontal and vertical recess channels between the worktops and pullouts or between the tall cabinets, which emphasise the design line of the kitchen. Like the metallic cabinet elements and fronts, they are anodised in a golden bronze colour, giving the kitchen a luxurious, yet cosy character.

The special SieMatic StoneDesign countertops, 1 cm thin in the wall area and 10 cm thick in the island area, are made of the same warm-white and hard-wearing Atalaia super blanco ceramic. The intricately mitred corners of the island fronts and side panels emphasise the quality and luxury of the home design. Together with the premium materials and the special SieMatic glass cabinets that echo the metal and lacquer colours of the kitchen, they give the S2 a whole new, even more inviting look.



This opens up new possibilities for elegant, purist kitchen design where the SieMatic kitchen itself is the focal point, but its functionality is not always visible. The exceptionally wide range of single, double and four-panel sliding side doors, with numerous height and width options, offers many possibilities for creating and concealing individual design areas. When closed, nothing disturbs the formal serenity of the SieMatic kitchen design, preserving its purist and timeless presence. With their understated elegance and unlimited functionality, SieMatic sliding doors can be playfully used as a fluid transition between rooms and their functions. Their versatility in aesthetics and function makes them ideal for highquality, full-height interior design in the SieMatic range of materials and colours, ensuring seamless continuity with SieMatic kitchen and living room design elements and finishes.





Our single and multi-panel sliding doors, which glide on perfectly smooth tracks and open effortlessly offer almost infinite design possibilities: from hiding the kitchen unit in a small apartment or the appliance areas in open-plan kitchens, to concealing a luxurious wine bar in a spacious loft, to creating passageways to the wet kitchen and utility room.

The optional lighting is activated when the doors are opened and the appliances are switched off when the doors are closed. This not only provides optimum lighting, but also highlights what was previously hidden It also prevents an oven that is in operation from being forgotten. A fascinating interplay that celebrates both perfect form and precise function.



A PASSION FOR PERFECTION.

With the increasing desire for invisible appliances, the concealed kitchen is becoming the new status symbol. The new SieMatic S2 kitchen generation proves that timelessly elegant design and the best combination of perfect craftsmanship and innovative technology are not a question of space. A clever solution for typical L-shaped kitchens is to hide small appliances on a pull-out behind a hinged door or lift-up flap. This unusual cabinet solution makes it possible to hide the appliances and then pull them out and use them on the shelf as required.

The sockets for the appliances are flush-mounted in the rear wall, the pull-out shelf has a magnetic stop to prevent accidental insertion, and a built-in sensor ensures that the lighting is automatically switched on when the shelf is opened. When closed, nothing interrupts the elegant atmosphere, and the walnut veneer, with its lively vertical grain and expressive finish, blends harmoniously into the overall kitchen design.

provides the necessary space for this ingenious mechanism. When closed, the 5 cm thick worktop, FUNCTIONALITY. which appears to hover above the recess channels, conceals the hob. However, the worktop can be divided and moved down the middle. The hob appears underneath. The edges on the three outer sides point downwards, revealing the 1 cm thick worktop with the hob underneath. The inserted segments snap into place, extending the work surface for a buffet, for example, or allowing it to be used as a dining area on both sides.

Worktops are spaces for creativity and experimentation, where new things emerge. This is exactly what we have done. We have designed a spectacular kitchen highlight with yet another innovative combination of technology and aesthetics. The innovative SecretSlide worktops of the SieMatic S2, integrating the kitchen even more seamlessly into the living area and making it multifunctional.





This not only creates a stunning effect, but also reveals the functional side of the kitchen beneath the flawless design of SecretSlide.

Thanks to a cushioned sliding mechanism and a soft stop in the end position, appliances, crockery or even glasses can be placed permanently on the sliding worktop without falling over.

SieMatic SecretService, a small, ingenious drawer discreetly concealed in the flat recess channel of the new generation SieMatic S2, demonstrates perfection in appearance and function. No technical detail detracts from the aesthetics. Highly customisable, this innovation provides ideal storage for flat and delicate items. Whether a set of knives, cheese and truffle slicers, smartphones and tablets or valuable jewellery, everything can be stored safely and quickly.

Well-designed dimensions with rounded corners allow flexible positioning of a variety of knife types and lengths, while strong magnets hold the two-piece knife holder and knives securely in place and prevent them from slipping. Magnetic dividers create individual compartments for other utensils. Equipped as standard with a dark grey flock mat for secure storage, SecretService is also available with knife holders or dividers in smoked chestnut and light oak to match the SieMatic aluminium interior and familiar MultiMatic features.

NOW YOU DON'T.

Integrated almost invisibly into the filigree recess channel, SecretService keeps its precious contents out of sight. Nothing disturbs the clean lines, periect angles and elegant presence of a handleless SieMatic S2. The hidden drawer opens gently only for those who know the secret, releasing its contents with a soft push to open action: purist aesthetics at its best.

The emotional SieMatic StoneDesign experience is available in many different versions, with materials ranging from natural stone to engineered stone and ceramic. Three different SieMatic StoneDesign materials with individual characteristics are available for countertops from 6.5 to 140 mm thick, monoblocks, extension tables, backsplashes and kitchen shelves.

VISIBLY INVISIBLE.

With StoneDesign, SieMatic facilitates extraordinary dimensions for natural and engineered stone. Because natural stone is quarried in blocks, only certain maximum slab sizes can be cut. However, thanks to a special, complex process with a barely perceptible sinusoidal joint, worktops in natural and composite stone are possible in lengths of over 4 metres or depths of over 2 metres.

A unique, resource-conserving process, in which a 'skin' of natural stone, composite or ceramic is applied to a load-bearing, steel-reinforced substructure, also permits a choice of thickness, from filigree to monolithic, from a visible 6.5 mm to 14 cm. This means that different thicknesses of the same material can be used in the same kitchen.

The high-precision sinusoidal joint technology allows seamless worktops to be created well beyond the usual dimensions.


